


Sunderland Museum & Winter Gardens building has two entrances: The HOLMESIDE COFFEE CAFÉ and the MAIN ENTRANCE






When I come through the MAIN ENTRANCE DOORS I can get some information from the VISITOR SERVICES STAFF

The lift is out of order at present.


Treetop Walkway

They will take me to the THE SPECIAL EXHIBITIONS GALLERY where I will FIND OUT about the activities we are doing










In the EXHIBITION I will SEE drawings by LEONARDO DA VINCI
