Mouth Care Matters (MCM) in the Community eLearning Programme.

Overview

The programme has been developed by the Directorate of Multi-Professional Dental Education in collaboration with NECS, as an easy-to-use eLearning package to support the health and social care workforce in promoting and improving oral health for those in residential and domiciliary care across the region.

The programme consists of 10 videos approximately 10 minutes long encompassing the core MCM principles and specialised modules to allow participants to complete the full programme or choose individual modules that are relevant to the clients they care for at a location and time that is convenient to them.

The eLearning consists of the following modules:

- · Oral health care training for managers
- Oral health and capacity and consent
- Oral health assessment frameworks
- Common oral health conditions
- Oral health for those with dysphagia
- Oral health for those with a cognitive impairment
- Oral health for those with a physical disability
- Oral health for those at the end of life
- Mouthcare
- Products and resources to support the health and social care team.
