

How To Book a GP Appointment Online- A Step by Step Guide



Introduction

Despite the current circumstances, always remember to see a GP whenever you need to. There are 2 ways to book an appointment:

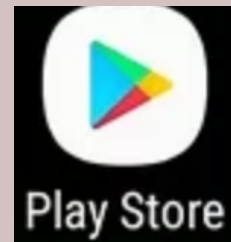
- By phoning your GP
- Using the NHS App



This guide will demonstrate how to book an appointment via the NHS app and find your surgery online. The NHS App can also be used for repeat prescriptions.

Via the NHS App

Step 1- Unlock your phone or tablet and click on the App Store (iPhone or iPad only) or the Play Store (Android Only)



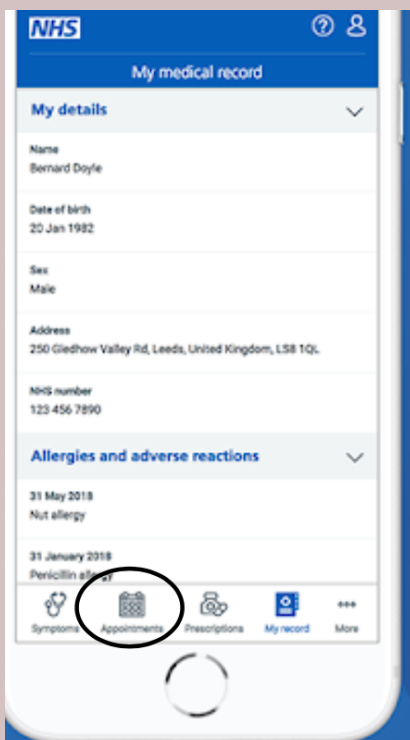
Step 2- Click the search box, type in "NHS App" and Download. Note, this is not the same as the COVID-19 App.



Step 3- Once you have Downloaded, open the App and click "Continue With NHS Login". Then, continue through the sign up process. The App will easily walk you through this. You will need an email address and a mobile phone to receive your security code.



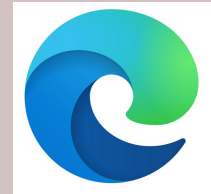
Step 4- Once you have done this click appointments (circled below) and prove identity. Then, you will be prompted to take a photo of your ID (Driving license or passport) to prove it's you.



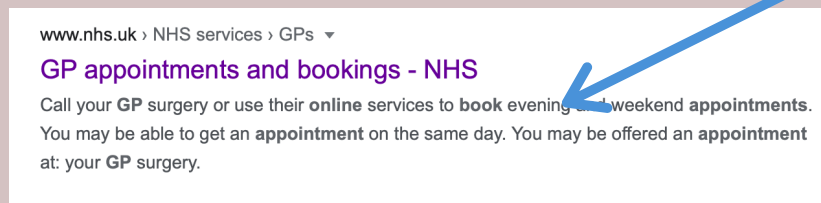
Step 5- After your identity has been verified, you will be able to choose from available appointment times over the next 8 weeks. Then, simply select the most convenient time for you. Please note, you cannot book urgent medical care over the app. This should be done by telephone- 999 emergency, 111 non-emergency.

How to find your GP Online

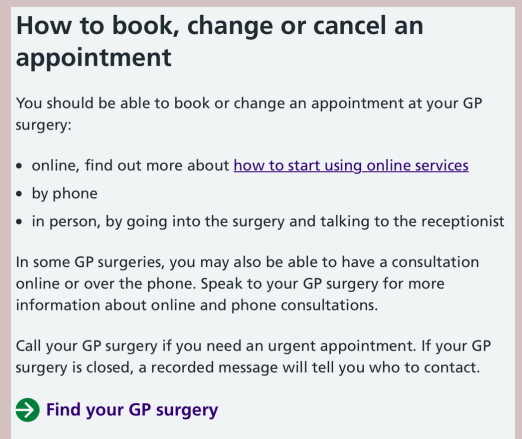
Step 1- Open your internet browser



Step 2- Click into the search bar and type "Book NHS doctors appointment online". Then click the option shown below



Step 3- Head to this section and click "Find your GP Surgery"



Step 4- Enter your postcode, city or town.

You can book an appointment:

- By telephone on (0191) 232 2973
- In-person (suspended March 2020 due to coronavirus)
- Online (via the NHS app - information link at the bottom of the page)

Types of Appointments

At Newcastle Medical Centre we offer the following types of appointments:

- Urgent appointments - allocated via triage
- Weekday GP appointments - pre-bookable 7 days and 4 weeks in advance.
- Nurse appointments - offering a range of services (blood tests, dressings, cervical screening, childhood immunisations, contraception services etc).
- Saturday appointments - available on select Saturdays with the GP, Advanced Nurse Practitioner and Practice Nurse. Saturday GP appointments are pre-bookable 3 days and 4 weeks in advance.
